

The Jabber Jaw Telecom SIP Trunking service is quick and easy to deploy and can work for your company in one of two ways depending on the type of phone system (PBX) that you currently have.

IP PBX Telephone Systems – Most new phone systems sold today fall into this category and are SIP-enabled. The Connection to the Jabber Jaw network is very simple with no additional equipment required as all end points (IP or Digital Phones) communicate with our switch through internet protocol.

Analog PBX Telephone Systems – Connecting your analog PBX to the Jabber Jaw network requires a SIP interface, VoIP gateway or ATA (analog telephony adapter). The ROI for this equipment is very short and cost effective.
